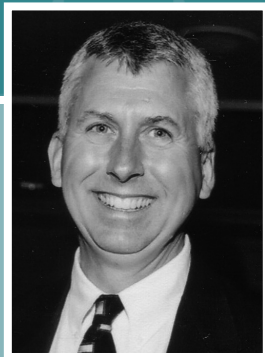
CAFHA is an association of private fair housing organizations, governmental bodies, and other concerned groups in the Chicago Metropolitan Area. CAFHA seeks to:

John was an active member of CAFHA, chair of the Oak Park Area Arts Council board, former chair of the Community Relations Commission, and former executive director of the Leadership Council for Metropolitan Open Communities. John passed away in December of 2007 after a lengthy battle with cancer.
